**SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES**

DOOR Atlanta partners with 32 agencies across the city. Participant service experiences may include:

- a local soup kitchen
- packing and sending medical supplies to third world countries
- working on a local urban farm

**EVENING PROGRAMMING**

Atlanta's evening programming focuses on the theme Bread for the Journey through:

- Group discussion facilitated by full time staff
- Art projects
- Community projects
- Speakers, including individuals who have transitioned from struggling with homelessness, motivational speakers or yearlong mission workers living and serving in Atlanta
